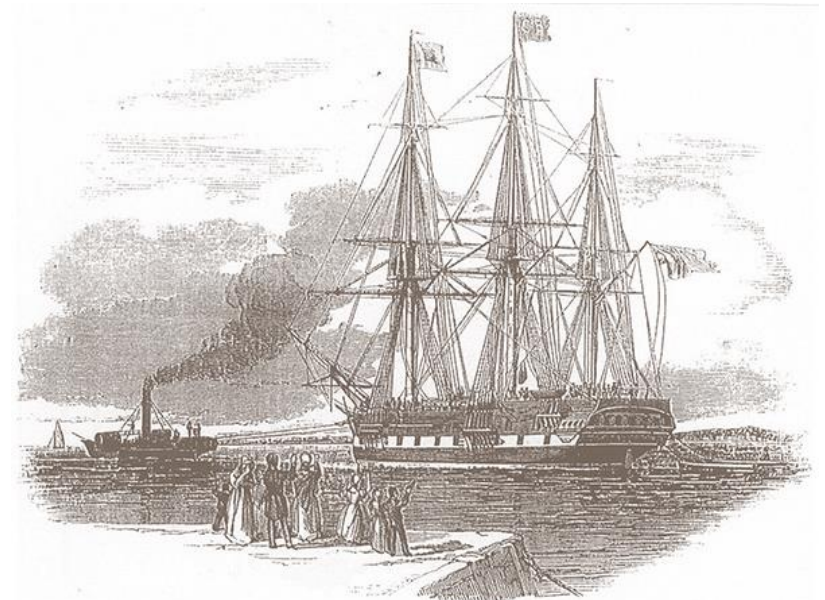

- *Research A-Z* – This gives an alphabetical list of research topics
- *Immigration and Shipping / Assisted Immigrants (digital) Shipping Lists* - Digital copies of passenger lists, ship by ship.
- *Indexes Online* – Under *Immigration* or *Shipping* a number of indexes and links can be found. An online copy service is available for some of these indexes - \$6.40 per entry + Admin Fee + Postage

- *Passenger records and immigration*
- The collection contains records of passengers arriving or departing Victoria, mostly as passenger lists. They are divided into:
 - Inward
 - Assisted (subsidised), unassisted (pay their own way) or coastal (travelling to Victoria from an Australian port)
 - Outward



Only available for searching in the library.

- Under SEARCH IMMIGRATION select *Search now*.
- Use NARROW BY CATEGORY then *Filter by location* to select a relevant database.
- Or go to FEATURED DATA COLLECTIONS and select *View all in card catalogue*. From here you can filter by collection and location to search a number of shipping databases.

Many of these entries have digital copies of the original records available to download.
